This patient's symptoms and CT imaging are most consistent with diagnosis of pulmonary embolism. Vital signs do not suggest patient is in extremis and there isn't any information to suggest patient is contraindicated for anticoagulation. Initial treatment should include therapeutic anticoagulation, of which heparinization is offered here.

Patient is afebrile, normal WBC, CT imaging, and symptoms presented do not suggest clinical evidence of pneumonia (Answer B) or intra-abdominal infection (Answer A/E).

If patient were contraindicated for anticoagulation, you should consider IVC filter placement (Answer D). Additional therapeutics such as thrombolytics and/or thrombectomy may be considered if patient is in extremis or shows evidence of right heart strain.


